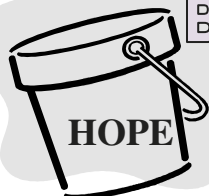

Items needed to fill buckets

BUCKET must be 5-gallon - new and unused

White preferably and no writing on them

- ◆ 5 pound bags long grain enriched rice
- ◆ 48 ounce plastic bottle cooking oil
 - ◆ 2 pound bags dry black beans (can substitute with red beans)
 - ◆ 5 pound bag of all purpose flour (not self rising)
- ◆ 20 ounce cylinder container of granulated white sugar (coffee service size)
 - ◆ 1 pound boxes spaghetti noodles
 - ◆ 1 - 40 ounce plastic jar of smooth peanut butter

PLEASE DO NOT SUBSTITUTE ANY ITEM LISTED
