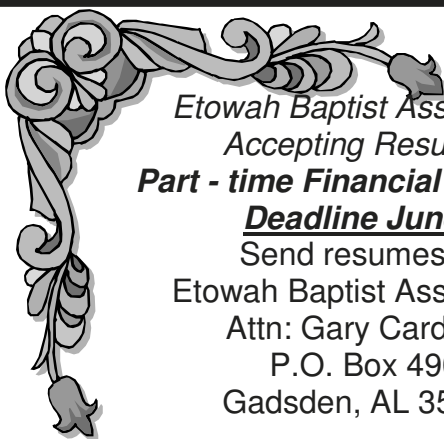

MISSIONS DEVELOPMENT MINISTRIES seek to engage Etowah Baptists in missions and ministries using the Acts 1:8 model to be witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea, in Samaria and to the uttermost parts of the world. This is done through association-based ministries such as the Missions Center, literacy missions, jail ministry, raceway ministries, and our missions partnerships with a North American and International missions partner location. In addition, our Missions development staff serves as a consultant/trainer for churches wishing to begin new ministries in their own communities. Assistance can be given in apartment ministry, mentoring ministries, Backyard Bible Clubs, health ministries, etc. The Special Projects Fund of the association provides start-up funds for churches to begin new ministries. Partnering to help your church to be On Mission for Christ is what we are all about.
