For a "full-time" wage, missionaries work approximately 40 hr/wk. In some circumstances, they may be asked to work extra shifts for a Vacation Bible School, Wednesday night, or weekend, which are optional and will be additionally paid hours. For a "part-time" wage, missionaries typically work either morning OR afternoon hours for approximately 20 hrs/wk. A wage will be provided for each day at the rate of \$12/hr for new employees, roughly 40 hr/wk for full-time employees. Returning employees with previous summer missions experience will make \$12.50 an hour.

\*Preference is given in hiring for those who work as full-time employees.
