Job Requirements:

- 1) Exemplify a growing relationship with Christ
- 2) Treat others with a Christ-like attitude
- 3) Drive yourself or arrange for your travel to and from assignments with other summer missionaries (must be age 16 through college to apply)
- 4) Be on time for assignments
- 5) Communicate well for yourself with director(s) and teammates.
- 6) Dress modestly and appropriately for activities (no short shorts/skirts or tops too short to be tucked)
- 7) Cannot be out more than **10 calendar days** June 1-July 19th (this is approximately 2 work weeks of summer). Please do not apply if you know that you will be traveling or out more than this.

Sample Work Week: (Occasional Sunday night or Friday VBS as church requested)

Monday: Morning @ Mission Center (8:30-11:30a); Afternoon @ Glencoe Elementary (1-3:30p); optional VBS (5-7 pm)

Tuesday: Morning @ EPTC (8:30-11:30a); Afternoon @ East Gadsden Community Center (1-3:30p); optional VBS (5-7 pm)

Wednesday: Canvassing neighborhood (9-11a); Afternoon @ YMCA Community Center (1-3:30p); Optional VBS (5-7 pm)

Thursday: Staff Meeting/Staff Bible Study(1-4 p); Cherry Street Park Ministry (5-7p);

Friday: (usually off on Fridays- with occasional extra hours available during a church VBS)

PLUS: Weekly Staff Meeting & Staff Bible Study (flexible around schedule)

For a “full-time” wage, missionaries work approximately 30-40 hr/wk. In some circumstances, they may be asked to work extra shifts for a Vacation Bible School, Wednesday night, or weekend. For “part-time,” missionaries typically work either morning OR afternoon hours for approximately 20 hrs/wk. A wage will be provided each day at the rate of \$12/hr for new employees. Returning employees with previous summer missions experience will make \$12.50/hr.

***Hiring preference is given for those who work as FULL-TIME employees**
